Which fertiliser is best for the garden?

Aim: We are trying 2 different fertilisers to see which one is best for the garden. We will measure the height of Broadbean seedlings to see which one grows the tallest. We are using water as a control.


Hypothesis: We think worm compost tea, because it comes from worms and worms make compost and compost Is good for the soil and it's part of the life cycle of the plant.

Equipment: Broadbean seeds, Seasol, worm tea, ruler, pots, potting mix, pencil and water

Method:

- 1. We planted our broad bean seedlings.
- 2. We watered them every day with the different fertilisers.
- 3. We measured them once a week after germination.
- 4. Then we made our bar graph to compare out measurements.

Conclusion: Worm tea did the best because they grew the most. When we calculated the average height of our 6 seedlings for each fertiliser, the worm tea was still the best even though one seed didn't germinate.
