The Enthusiasm of Students towards this Poster Project

Aim: To determine the attitude of the Student body in HSPA in accordance to creating this project.

We have set up a survey to allow free expression of what the Students of HSPA think of this Task. The survey was then randomly sent to be filled in by five year 11 boys, five year 11 girls, five year 12 boys, and five year 12 girls. The question of rating the project out of five has been constructed into a table seen below. The question asked "Did you enjoy working on the Poster Project?", the rating was given from 1 being bad, to 5 being great.
